TERMS AND CONDITIONS of RESERVATION

Reservations

1. Reservation Tenure

- Under the Cemeteries Act a Right of Burial may be reserved for future use and is subject to 25 years' tenure from date of the Reservation. A right of burial relates to a rockery, rose garden, niche wall or shrub garden memorial site. If the Right of Burial has not been exercised at the end of this period, you will be offered the option of re-reserving.

2. Payment

- The Reservation fee is payable to the Rye Cemetery Trust and is a non-deductable, non-refundable fee. This fee will cover the maintenance of the gravesite for the term of the tenure.
- The full amount for the purchase of the site is payable at the time of use at the full gazetted fee at whatever it may be at that time.
- The interment must be paid in full before an interment can take place.

3. Interment

- A fee is required to be paid each time an interment takes place. The interment fee is for the digging and re-filling costs.
- When an interment has taken place in a memorial site the tenure is no longer applicable, this site is then held in a 25 year tenure or perpetuity.

4. Right of Burial

- When you reserve or purchase a memorial site and full payment has been received, you are purchasing the right to inter in that specific location.

5. Authorisation

- Authority is required from the holder of the Right of Interment before any arrangements can be made regarding the memorial site.

6. Cancellation

- If a reservation is cancelled then the relevant maintenance fee is applicable and not refundable.
- If the terms of the agreement are not adhered to, The Rye Cemetery Trust reserves the right to renegotiate the reservation.

Additional Conditions relating to Memorial Sites with Monumental Work:

7. Monumental Permit Fees

- Monumental work cannot be carried out unless the full fees have been paid on the site.
- A Monumental Permit Fee applies when a monument is required. The fee varies depending on the extent of the work being carried out. Monumental Permit Fees enable Rye Cemetery Trust to verify the quality of the work being done and ensure that the monument is not infringing on a neighbouring site.

The Rye Cemetery Trust is incorporated under the Cemeteries Act 2003 and is legislated by the Department of Health, State Government of Victoria
